Advanced Multi-Stage Filtration

Each Salon Pure Air system includes multi-stage filtration for superior protection:

- Multi-density media filters for fine dust removal
- High-capacity activated carbon modules for chemical vapors and odors
- Additional media filters for enhanced contaminant removal

Optional filter upgrades include HEPA, ULPA, or VOC-specific filters for specialized applications.

Engineered for Safety and Reliability

All Salon Pure Air systems are built so air passes through the filters and carbon module before reaching the blower. Each blower is UL and CE listed for safety and designed for long-term reliability.

Flexible capture options include compatibility with manicure tables, tabletop hoods, and adjustable extractor arms that draw fumes away from breathing zones.
